Dear resident of Swanland,

**The Swanland Village Hall '100 Club'** is to enable subscribers to participate in a monthly draw, which has the aim of raising money to help equip the Hall. During the first half 2009 the club had approximately **136 members**. Half the money raised (after deducting expenses) is used to buy items required for the hall and the other half is allocated to a prize fund.

The draws take place on the last Saturday of each month and there is an additional draw at Christmas time. Every month there are three prizes in each draw. Over the last two years, the first prizes in the monthly draw have not been less than **£50** and in the Christmas draw not less than **£200**.

So far, the money raised has helped to purchase the following equipment for the Hall:

**Lapel Radio Microphone £470**  
**Table Trolley £177**  
**50 Stacking Chairs £480,**  
**Contribution towards the lift for People with Disabilities £2,112,**  
**Crockery for the kitchen £173,**  
**Contribution towards the Dishwasher £640.**  
**Contribution to the Sound System £1130**  
**Contribution to the Staging £1760**  
**Notice Board for Library Corridor £50**

But we still need more support to obtain further items that will enhance your village hall. **If you have already joined the '100 Club' - thank you for your support.** If you have not already joined there is still time to do so. The cost is **£24 per annum** payable in advance preferably by standing order. The prize fund will be allocated as follows:

Monthly Draw – Three quarters of the monthly prize fund with 60% as 1st prize, 25% as 2<sup>nd</sup> & 15% as 3<sup>rd</sup>.

Christmas Draw – One quarter of each month's prize fund accumulated with 60% as 1st prize, 25% as 2<sup>nd</sup> & 15% as 3<sup>rd</sup>.

If you would like to participate please complete the application form and **standing order** (including inserting the month you wish payment to be made which should generally be the next month after completing the form) and return to myself. It would greatly assist us by reducing our costs if you could pay by Standing Order.

However, if you wish, you can pay by **cheque** (payable to "Swanland Village Hall 100 Club"). and return to myself. We are registered with East Riding of Yorkshire Council to run a lottery and a copy of the rules can be sent to you if required.
